## Farm Machinery

**Some Examples** - Rice, Wheat, Cotton, Nuts

**Grains**-wheat, corn, rye, oats, barley

**Fruits** - apples, pears, peaches, plums oranges, olives, figs, cranberries, avocados, pineapples

**Vegetables** - tomatoes, lettuce, spinach, celery, potatoes, radishes, broccoli

**Cattle Food** - alfalfa, clover, hay, grasses
